Nomination Form

Please read the following carefully to comply with the nomination guidelines.

Nominations:

Any individual and/or entity, living or deceased can be considered for induction into the Madison Area Soccer Hall of Fame. They may be nominated for but not limited to the following categories:

Player

Coach

Official

Builder

Criteria & Information:

The “Madison Area” is defined as **Dane County**; the geographical area where the nominee must have been involved in the game of soccer.

It is expected that all nominees have **at least 4 years** of experience in the Madison area soccer community.

A Builder must have made his/her mark in soccer in a non-playing capacity and had a major, sustained and/or positive impact on the Madison area soccer community.

Nominees who have demonstrated a proficiency in more than one category may receive priority consideration by the MASHoF Board.

All nominees must be free of all ethical concerns that might compromise the values of MASHoF.

For nominations to be considered, the Nomination Form must be filled in completely and accurately. Nominations must be typed or printed legibly on the nomination form. The onus is on the nominator to provide the most complete information about the nominee so that the MASHoF Board can make educated decisions. All Board decisions will be final.

The nomination window **opens January 1st** of each year. MASHoF must receive Nomination Forms **on or before April 15th** of each year. The induction ceremony will occur later in the year at a date and place to be determined by the MASHoF Board.

Attachments to nominations forms can be letters of support, articles and documents related to the nominee's achievements and contributions to the game of soccer.

All nominations will remain on file with MASHoF for a period of **5 years**. If a nominee is not selected for induction during this time frame, the individual and/or entity may be re-nominated.
