## The Italian-American Women's Club (IAWC)

was founded on February 22, 1934, as a mutual aid society to benefit the Italian-American women of the Greenbush neighborhood in Madison. Today, we are a non-profit organization with membership open to any woman who shares an interest in Italian language and culture. You do not need to be Italian to join. Besides the activities and events we sponsor or participate in, we award annual scholarships to Dane County high school graduates (young women or men) who are pursuing further education, and have an interest in Italian culture.

## Dues

The annual dues amount is dependent on the age of the applicant, payable each February:

- ◆ \$30 - Under 80 years old (new and continuing)
- ◆ \$10 - 80 years old or over (new and continuing)
- ◆ \$15 - **New members only** - after July 15, membership dues reduced to \$15 for the rest of that calendar year

## Meetings

IAWC members meet the first Wednesday of each month from 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm, at St. Joseph's Church, 1905 W. Beltline Hwy, Madison, 53713-2335. If you need transportation to come to a meeting, please let us know.

## Structure
