

LeRoi Jones Has Demands for UW

Black playwright LeRoi Jones has issued a number of demands for his scheduled appearance at the University of Wisconsin Student Symposium Feb. 23 and 24.

Jones demanded that only black students meet him at the airport and that they be at his disposal during his stay here; that if a seminar is held only black students be allowed to attend; that a dinner be held with blacks only; and that the middle aisle be reserved for blacks if a speech is given.

A performance of Jones' play, "Black Mass," was scheduled at the University, and Jones was to give a speech the next day in the Student Union.

Kenneth Spitzer, symposium chairman, said there would be no seminar with Jones.

Spitzer also said there are not enough Negroes on the campus to fill the center aisle, but the first 10 rows, normally reserved for the symposium committee, would be reserved for Negroes.
