

# Cardinal Labels Black Demands as 'Impossible'

The Daily Cardinal, the University of Wisconsin student newspaper, stated editorially Saturday that the demands of Wisconsin black students are "impossible."

The paper, which has been threatened by the Board of Regents with a financial cutoff because of use of alleged obscenities, compared the demands with the French revolt last May. "When 'be a realist, demand the impossible' was the call-word."

The editors, while claiming that the University has been touched by racism, attacked the principle of separating the races, which they say black students are demanding.

The Cardinal concluded by saying that the "post-revolutionary" order must consist of black and white and teacher and student. "This does not appear to be the new order offered by the revolution now facing us at the University."
