

## **Extra Police Force Costs \$7,700 a Day**

The extra Madison and Dane County lawmen force, assigned to the University of Wisconsin campus, is costing about \$7,700 per day, Sheriff Vernon (Jack) Leslie and City Police Inspector Herman Thomas reported Tuesday night.

The state will be billed for payment to the nearly 200 officers working overtime to help the 30-member University police force, County Board Chairman Richard J. Pire said.

Pire said he is concerned that the officers are becoming so fatigued they may be susceptible to colds and flu.

The state paid overtime wages for lawmen who aided

campus police in previous campus demonstrations, including the riotous October, 1967, Dow Chemical Co. recruiting resistance on Bascom Hill.

State payment for local officers, who helped quell student disturbances at Oshkosh and Whitewater State Universities, has not yet been approved by the Legislature despite recommendation from the State Universities Board of Regents.
