

Six Arrested for Disruptions on Bascom Hill

Six men students — five from the University of Wisconsin and one from Carleton College, Northfield, Minn. — were arrested Wednesday afternoon during demonstrations on Bascom Hill.

All six were charged with disorderly conduct for refusing to obey police orders to unblock class building entrances.

The Wisconsin students were Sanford L. Sherman, 27, of 1108 E. Gorham St., from Glen Ridge, N.J.; Lewis D. Pepper, 22, of 547 E. Mifflin St., from New York, N.Y.; Harvey Clay, 19, Chamberlain House dormitory, from San Angelo, Tex.; Fred H. Marshall, 19, Sellery Hall dormitory, from Appleton; and Arthur R. Winnig, 19, of 139 W. Gilman St., from Neenah.

The sixth student arrested identified himself as Michael Seth Dash, 18, a Carleton College student and native of Northfield, Minn., temporarily staying at 15 N. Bassett St.

All six were released on \$107 cash bail each, supplied by campus friends, pending Criminal Court trial later.
