

# 6 More Arrests on UW Campus Put Total at 31

Six more demonstrators on the University of Wisconsin campus, including two co-eds, were arrested Monday on disorderly conduct charges for disobeying police and National Guardsmen trying to keep order.

The arrests made 31 since demonstrations started a week ago Saturday. Six of them, arrested Friday, appeared in Judge William L. Buentzli's Criminal Court Monday and were released on \$107 bail each for later court hearings after entering innocent pleas.

All of the earlier arrested students also are at liberty on bail for court hearings scheduled through April.

Arrested Monday, and released on \$107 bail each for court appearance today, were:

Natalie Fox, 21, of 516 W. Doty St., student from Chicago.

Dorothy Brown, 19, Kronshage Hall, student from Milwaukee.

Kenneth Goldberg, 19, of 1805 University Ave., student from Boston, Mass.

Bobby Turbeville, 26, an ex-student who told jailers he had no local address and no occupation, from Tyler, Tex.

Ross W. McIntosh, 21, of 412 N. Lake St., a student from Washington, D.C.

John E. Xavier, 22, of 417 State St., a University teaching assistant from Mentor, Minn.

Campus police checked out three false fire alarms during Monday's demonstrations, at Bascom Hall and the Social Sciences and Commercial Buildings. Madison firemen were not called to any of the alarms.
