

Two Protesters' Court Trials Set

Two students arrested in the February demonstrations at the University of Wisconsin over black student demands were set for trial in Circuit Court Wednesday.

Daniel W. LaFond, 20, of 17 N. Butler St., from Marquette, Mich., and Dennis Gordon, 18, Ogg Hall, from Chicago, Ill., entered innocent pleas.

Circuit Judge Norris Maloney set trials tentatively for the last week in March or the first week in April.

LaFond is charged with disorderly conduct. Gordon also faces disorderly conduct charges and is charged with unauthorized use of a loudspeaker. Both remain free on bail.
