

UW Seeks 'Major' Amount to Beef Up Security Force

The University of Wisconsin will ask the State Board on Government Operations (BOGO) for a "major" allocation Friday to provide additional security for its Madison and Milwaukee campuses.

Two months ago a UW request for \$151,960 for 24 additional policemen and six security personnel for the two campuses was rejected by BOGO.

AT THAT TIME BOGO told the University to contract for the additional help it needed. The UW maintained it did not have the funds to do so.

Harvey Breuscher, a special assistant to UW Pres. Fred Harvey Harrington, met with Madison police officials Wednesday to explore avenues open to

the UW.

A UW SPOKESMAN said that should the decision be to contract for additional personnel, it could be done either with governmental units or private security forces.

He said the details of the proposal to be presented to BOGO have not yet been completed and the amount to be sought has not yet been determined.
