

## Afro-American Center Gets \$14,000 Fund

The Martin Luther King Fund of the University of Wisconsin presented \$14,000 to the Afro-American Center Tuesday night.

C. Elrie Chrite, the newly-appointed director of the center, said the money would be used to create a small loan fund for students, to build up the center's library, and to provide financial assistance to students not receiving adequate scholarships.

The check for \$14,000 was presented to Chrite by Kit Lunney, chairman of the community relations committee of the fund. She said the money was raised from various fund-raising activities.

The Afro-American Center went into full operation last spring. Its goal, according to Chrite, is to "respond to the needs of Black students on the University of Wisconsin campus."

He said the \$14,000 would be a useful supplement to the budget money the center receives from the University.
