

UW Math Center to Get New Home in WARF Building

The Mathematics Research Center, bombed out of its Sterling Hall quarters Aug. 24, will be one of the tenants in the Wisconsin Alumni Research Foundation (WARF) building now nearing completion.

The building is on the University of Wisconsin campus at Observatory Dr. and Walnut St.

UW officials said university departments and divisions would begin moving into the structure Jan. 7. The math center will occupy the 11th floor and some other areas in the building.

The math center, funded by the United States Army, has been scattered around the campus since the bombing.

Also moving into the building will be the Departments of Planning and Construction, Environmental Design, and Educational Administration; part of the Department of Rural Sociology, three units of the Medical Center, Office of Space Management, University-Industry Research Program, and the campus data processing division.

Much of the WARF building is being leased by the UW, and some of the offices there eventually will move to new structures elsewhere.
