

State Grand Jury Probe to Start in Bombing Case

State and county law enforcement officials are expected to begin selecting Grand Jurors today for a secret investigation of the Army Math Center-Sterling Hall bombing last August.

Dane County Dist. Atty. Gerald Nichol said Wednesday he had been sworn to secrecy.

Federal warrants were issued for four men last September, charging them with sabotage, conspiracy to commit sabotage, and destruction of government property.

Charged were Karleton L. Armstrong, 24, and Dwight A. Armstrong, 19, his brother, both of Madison; David S. Fine, 18, of Wilmington, Del.; and Leo F. Burt, 22, of Havertown, Pa.

Informed sources had indicated that there was no reason to expect that anyone but the four men, whose whereabouts are unknown, would be named in any state warrants produced by the Grand Jury.
