

# Sterling Hall Toll Set at \$2.1-Million

Total damage caused to University of Wisconsin buildings in the August, 1970, bombing of Sterling Hall has been placed by state officials at \$2,125,000.

Damage to the Old Main building at Whitewater in a February, 1970, fire was set at \$1,061,425.

day by Atty. Gen. Robert Warren.

Warren said the losses were being reported in the 1971 annual Fire Marshal Bureau Review because precise figures were not available when the 1970 publication was drafted.

The attorney general said total damage caused by fires of known or probable incendiary origin and explosions and bombings in 1971 amounted to \$2,462,731.

The 1971 figure, he said, did not include fire loss resulting from rioting at the Wisconsin state reformatory in Green Bay Nov. 12, 1971. That loss was set at \$152,000.
