

Young Testifies at Bomb Probe

University of Wisconsin Chancellor H. Edwin Young was one of the witnesses called Thursday before the Dane County grand jury continuing an investigation of the Sterling Hall-Army Math Research Center bombing last August. ✓

It is not known how long this grand jury, conducted by Dane County Dist. Atty. Gerald Nichol, will be convened, nor when indictments, if any, can be expected. ADP 8 1971

One staff member said the group is not scheduled to convene daily, but rather in portions throughout the week. The staff member estimated the probe would take a total of 10 days to complete.

Four men were indicted by a Federal Grand Jury last year on charges of destruction of federal property, conspiracy to destroy government property, and sabotage.

Charged were Karleton L. Armstrong, 24, and Dwight A. Armstrong, 19, his brother, both of Madison; David S. Fine, 18, of Wilmington, Del.; and Leo F. Burt, 22, of Havertown, Pa.
