

Tommy Thompson's corporate empire

Since resigning as President George W. Bush's secretary of U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) four years ago, former Wisconsin Gov. Tommy Thompson has amassed a lucrative portfolio of high-level corporate positions, some of them in companies he once regulated or which do business with the federal government.

Below is a summary of Thompson's corporate portfolio and what connection, if any, each company has to the federal government. Compensation figures are included in parentheses if they were reported by publicly held companies and include annual salary, fees and stock options. Thompson's earnings from private companies aren't listed.
