### HOW THE SCORES WERE TABULATED

The Wisconsin State Journal's analysis of districts' data includes only students who completed the previous full academic year in a single school within each district. The analysis of state data, though, includes all students in the state.

You may see slightly differing numbers elsewhere if, for example, the data include students who switched schools within a district.

Also, numbers in other analyses may differ because of the rounding of percentages.

Belleville and Deerfield district officials supplied data that weren't included in files provided to the newspaper by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction.
